## B Exercise 4 (Track 6)

Mr Miller: $\quad$ Miller, hello.
Mareike Schröder: Guten Tag, Herr Miller. Greenhouse Bank, Mareike Schröder ist mein Name. Ich rufe an, um Ihnen als unserem Kunden unsere neuesten Angebote zu präsentieren.

The annual interest rate amounts to $15.25 \%$ at the moment.
