It's the smallest projector of its kind on the market, only ten centimetres by eight centimetres, and it's also very thin - only five centimetres. It weighs just under a kilogram. As you can see, it's small enough to fit in your pocket, so it's easily portable. The outer casing is now available in two colours, polished aluminium or white. I think you'll agree that it's very stylish, but it's also robust.

At the same time, it's packed with state-of-the-art technology. The LED projector is easy-to-use and it's also reliable. As far as technology is concerned, the most important feature is the LED lamp. This reaches full power after a few seconds, without producing any heat. And since no heat is produced, there's no risk of expensive bulb damage – and it's quiet! There's no need for a fan to cool down the bulb. Oh, and there's a two year guarantee on all the interior parts.

As you'd expect with a top-end projector like this, the Baby Beam comes with a full range of accessories, including USB hub connector, an extension cable, and a spare lamp. It also comes with this attractive nylon shoulder bag, which has special anti-shock padding in case it's dropped. Also included are cleaning materials and a comprehensive instruction book in six languages.

Now, even though the Baby Beam is a highly sophisticated product, it's very competitively priced. It retails at only 150 euros which represents excellent value for money. So, whether for private or corporate use, this slim and elegant projector makes real sense to users who want advanced technology that is affordable and convenient.
