- 1 Hong Kong is in the south of China. Over 7.2 million people live there. It has a multicultural society with many different religions, festivals and languages. Hong Kong used to be a British colony, but in 1997 it became a part of China again. However, it has kept its own political and financial system.

- 4. What problems does the city have? The city has problems with air pollution and there are great differences between the rich and the poor in the city.


