


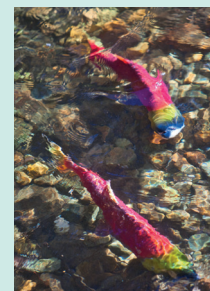

Sockeye salmon¹

1 The Adams River runs from the Monashee Mountains of British Columbia to the Pacific Ocean. On its way it travels for about 400 kilometres through several lakes and joins other rivers. However, what makes the Adams River special is a kind of fish that lives here – the sockeye salmon¹. These fish are born in the river and spend the first year of their life there. After that they go on a challenging 2,000-kilometre journey to the Pacific Ocean and then go all the way to Alaska. Three years later they return to the place where they were born, and it only takes them 17 days. This demanding return journey is a wonder of nature. The fish have to swim up the river and even jump up waterfalls. Along the way the fish stop eating and change color from green to bright red. When they get back, they lay eggs and die. Nobody knows why, but every four years the number of salmon that return is especially large – millions. In 2010 there were about 34 million. In other years it is only hundreds. The next big years are 2022 and 2026. During these years the salmon will fascinate up to 200,000 tourists who come to the area to watch them.

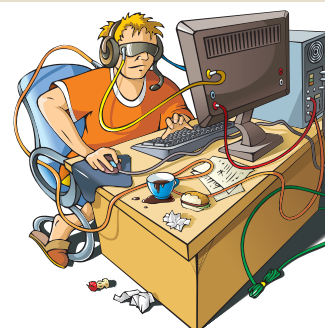

ADDICTED TO ONLINE GAMES

1 Doctors know a lot about drug and alcohol addiction¹ and how to
 2 treat these diseases, but there's a new kind of addiction that is
 3 affecting people around the world, young and old. It is the
 4 addiction to online games. Over the years online games have
 5 become more popular because the graphics are better, the
 6 characters are more fascinating, and gamers can play with other
 7 gamers anywhere in the world. The definition of addiction is when
 8 you cannot stop doing or using something, usually something that can hurt you.
 9 An addiction can destroy your health, your family, your friendships and your life.



10 Why is this addiction so dangerous? Addicted gamers often forget to eat and/or sleep enough
 11 because they are so involved in their game. Because they can play with people around the
 12 world, they play at strange times. Not sleeping and eating can seriously affect their health.
 13 Addicted gamers don't take part in any other social activities because they spend all of their
 14 free time online. Sometimes the gaming world even replaces the real one. In the fantasy world,
 15 a gamer can develop a character that is very different from himself or herself – a character that
 16 is stronger, more successful and maybe with a better social life. This can help them to escape
 17 from the real world, which they may find hard.

18 Some online games are more addicting than others. For example, some games require a
 19 strong commitment because you can only get to higher levels if you spend a lot of time
 20 playing. Often gamers are playing against each other, so if a gamer takes a break or doesn't
 21 spend enough time playing, then he or she loses. In other games, gamers around the world
 22 have to work together to win, so they are dependent on each other. Games with an open
 23 end are also more addictive as well as games that use money. Any kind of money is a strong
 24 motivation to continue playing so it can also become very expensive.
