## **B Exercise 2 (Track 8)**

I'm afraid you have a rather tedious job in front of you.

Ute Huber: Oh no, what's that then?

Patrick Exelby: You'll have to go through your house, assessing the value of your contents.

Ute Huber: I see what you mean by tedious! Do you have any suggestions as to the best

wav?

Patrick Exelby: Well, personally, I recommend making an inventory broken down by room.

So for example you write "kitchen" on a piece of paper and then itemize what's in there. What electrical items have you got in your kitchen?

Ute Huber: Erm, oven, fridge freezer, microwave, various appliances like mixer, juicer.

Patrick Exelby: Dishwasher? Electric kettle?

*Ute Huber:* Oh yes, those too.

Patrick Exelby: Well, you write down the items, along with their replacement value. Oven

400, fridge freezer 300, microwave 60 – these are just examples of course – dishwasher 250, kitchen appliances 150 and so on. If an item is quite new and you have the receipt, you can use that value, otherwise you'll have to check in the shops what the current value would be. Then you just do the

same with every room.

Ute Huber: It sounds a very long and boring job!

Patrick Exelby: I'm afraid it is, but look at it this way, when you've done it once, you'll only

need to update it or add to it for the future.

Ute Huber: That's true; that's a positive way of looking at it.

Patrick Exelby: Oh and don't forget the attic, or cellar, if you have either. Or your CD

collection. Or the contents of cupboards and boxes – you'd be surprised how

many people forget about those. Do you have a garden or a garage?



Ute Huber: Yes, both.

Patrick Exelby: Well, don't forget items in them as well! And while you're at it, take photos

of any valuables you have – that will be really helpful if any of them get

stolen or damaged in a fire.

Ute Huber: Anything else?

Patrick Exelby: When you've finished, add up the total value of your contents. This will

be the minimum insurance sum for which you'll need coverage. Then call me back and we'll see if there's anything on your list that we'll need to list separately on the policy.
