b) Explain Mrs Azad’s refusal to accept this view.
4. Choose one of the following tasks:
 - a)** Against the background of this passage discuss the issues of racism and integration of Muslim immigrants into a Western society.
 - b)** People need to know where their roots are. Give your personal opinion.
 - c)** Open borders – a gateway to crime or a chance to unite peoples? Discuss.
