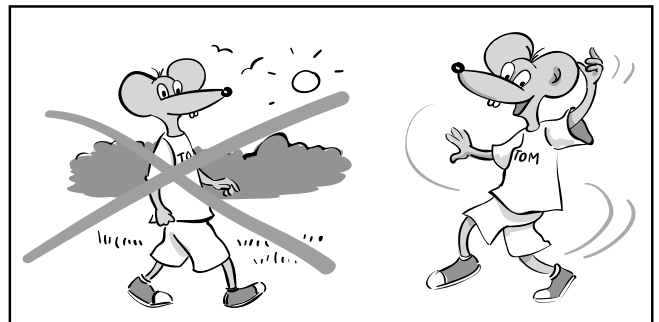
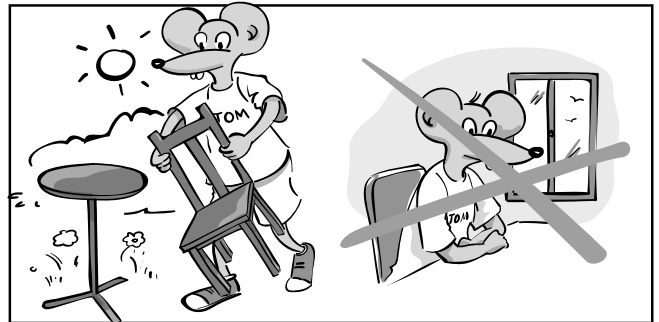
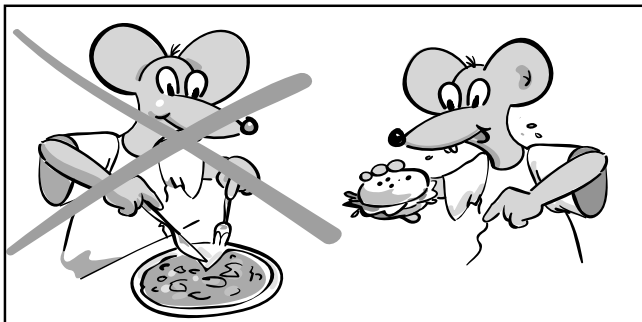
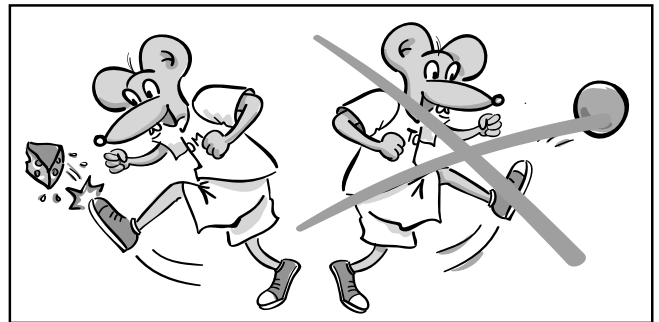
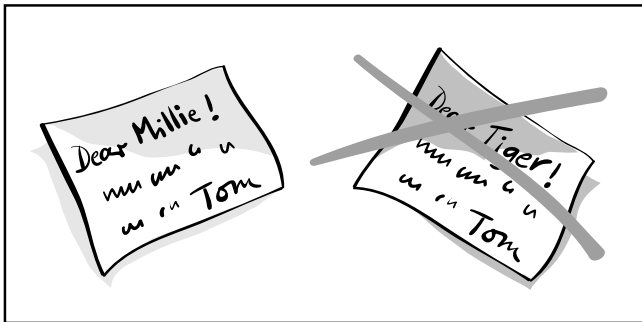
- a) Write down five sentences about Tom. What does he (not) want to do on his birthday? Look at the example.
