Partner A: What's number 1 down?

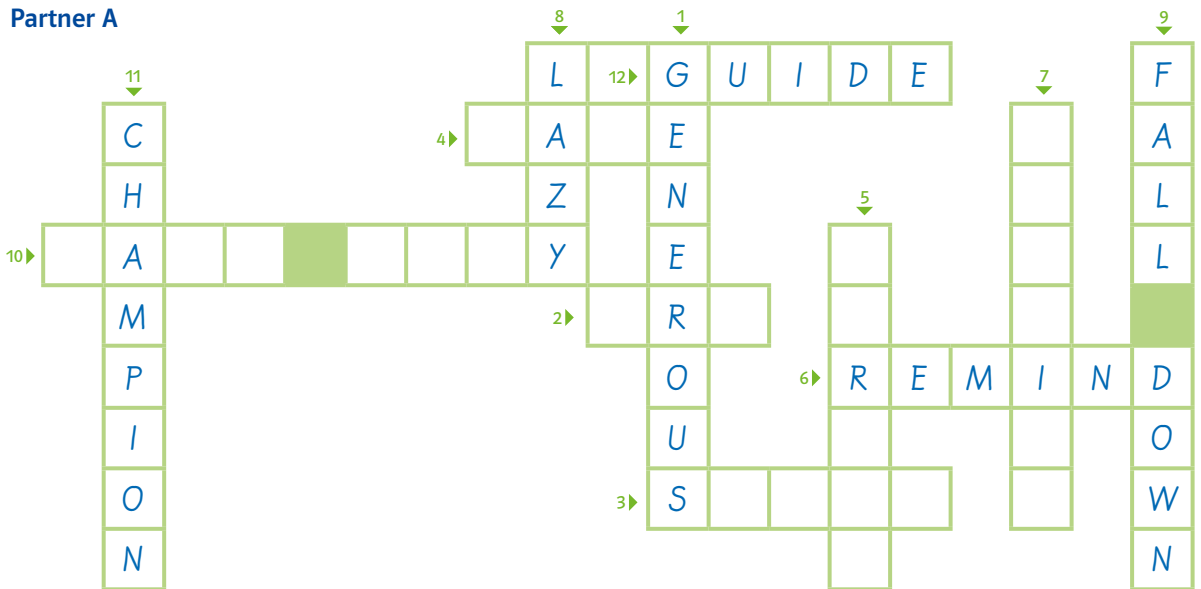

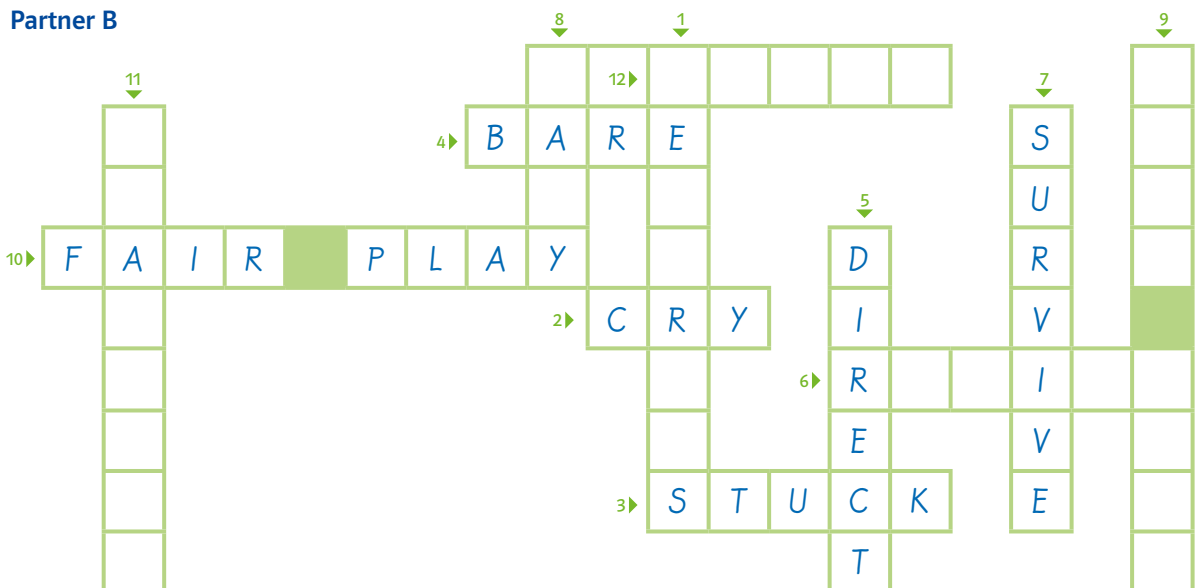

3 Pictures of happiness

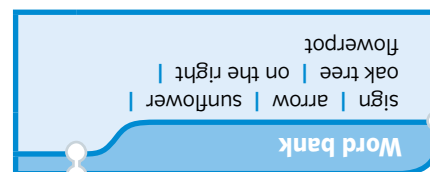

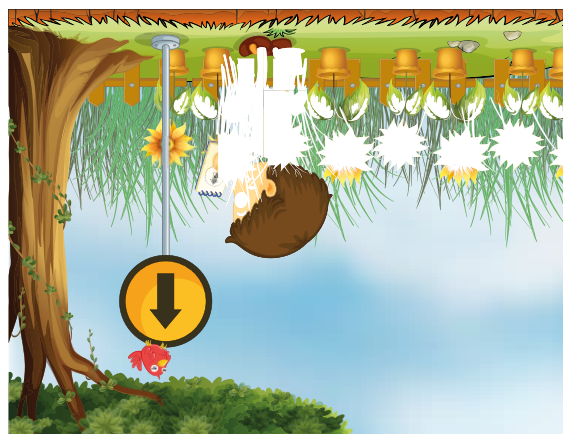
