<b>keyring</b> ['ki:,rɪŋ]	Schlüsselanhänger
<b>mobile phone charm</b> [ˌməʊbaɪl 'fəʊn ,tʃɑ:m]	Handyanhänger
<b>money-box</b> ['mʌni ,bɒks]	Spardose
<b>wallet</b> ['wɒlɪt]	Geldbeutel



<b>costume</b> ['kɒstju:m]	Kostüm
<b>hat</b> [hæt]	Hut
<b>mask</b> [mɑ:sk]	Maske
<b>wig</b> [wɪɡ]	Perücke



<b>colouring pencil</b> ['kɒlərɪŋ ,pensl]	Buntstift
<b>craft kit</b> ['krɑ:ft ,kɪt]	Bastelset
<b>magnet</b> ['mæɡnɪt]	Magnet
<b>sticker</b> ['stɪkə]	Aufkleber; Sticker

There's one piece missing.	( <i>Es fehlt ein Teil.</i> )
