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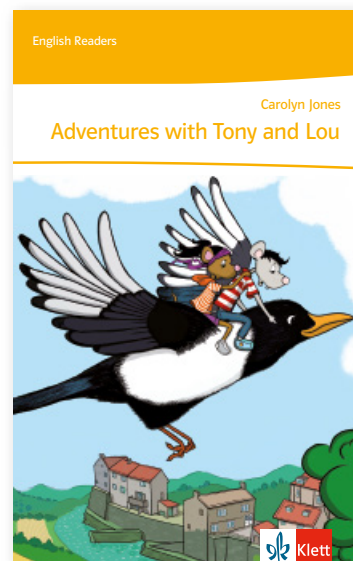
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## Teil A

Tony schleicht herunter und die Mäuse verstecken sich in einem Astloch bis die Katze weg ist.

Sie heißt Maggie und Tony erfährt, dass ihr Mann ihr oft „Geschenke“ bringt. Tony und die Elster werden Freunde und so bringt Maggie Tony und Lous Sachen zurück zu ihrem Mauseloch. Lou ist glücklich, als sie ihr Fahrrad wieder hat.

### 3 Landeskunde

#### Kostümpartys in Großbritannien

Sich zu verkleiden hat in Großbritannien eine lange Tradition. So kommt schon in Shakespeares Theaterstück „Romeo und Julia“ ein Maskenball vor.

Eine Karnevalssaison wie man sie in Deutschland kennt, gab es in England jedoch nur bis zum 16. Jahrhundert. Sie wurde „Shrovetide“ genannt und im Zuge der Reformation abgeschafft.

Heute gibt es Karnevalsumzüge in Großbritannien nur bei Veranstaltungen wie dem Notting Hill Carnival, der im Sommer stattfindet und mit seinen schrillen Kostümen und der rhythmischen Musik eher an den Karneval in Rio erinnert.

Umso mehr nutzen die Briten alle möglichen anderen Anlässe, um sich ins Kostüm zu werfen, z. B. zu Halloween, beim Pfannkuchen-Wettrennen am Shrove Tuesday oder beim St. Patrick's Day, an dem gern grün getragen wird.

Auch privat sind Kostüm- und Mottopartys in Großbritannien äußerst beliebt. Und die Kleinen feiern ihren Kindergeburtstag am liebsten mit Verkleidung.

#### Die Briten und ihr Strand

Als Inselbewohner sind die Briten immer schnell am Meer. Egal, wo man wohnt, die Küste ist nie mehr als 70 Meilen (ca. 113 km) entfernt. Kein Wunder also, dass Badeorte – besonders die mit Sandstränden – sehr beliebte Ausflugs- und Ferenziele sind.

- B: Lou wants the photographer to see her, so she puts on a colourful hat. Then a seagull steals her hat!
- C: The friends want Lou to play volleyball, but Lou doesn’t want to. She sits on a stone and watches so the photographer can see her. But then the volleyball hits her and she falls into the sand!
- D: Lou goes in a boat with her friends. It looks like fun and she thinks the photographer can take great pictures of her on the water. But the boat can’t hold all of the friends and they fall into the water! Now Lou isn’t happy!
